Shillings and Sixpence by the year, which is due and payable to  
Achilles Daunt Esquire as a composition for the tithes of said  
Parish payable by him as Lessee of the impropriate tithes thereof,  
and I further certify that the average price of Wheat being the com  
purchally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending  
on the First of November One thousand Eight hundred and thirty is  
Two Bolls Three Shillings and Two half pence per Bolls, Given  
under my hand this Thirtieth day of October One thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty three
