and just amount of composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is five Shillings
and Forty seven pence thirteen shillings and five
pence by the year, which sum is due and
payable to the Rev^d Richard Madeliffe as Rector
of the said Parish

And I do further certify that the average
value of Tithes being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st day of November 1831 is five
Pounds twelve shillings and three pence
halfpenny
