

To all whom these presents shall come. I
the Reverend Richard Radcliffe Rector and Vicar of
the Parish of St. Mary's Emmenthy in the ^{County of Wick} and
quelling Whereas Lynden Bolton of Minkstown Castle
in the County of Dublin Esquire has truly
served me with a Notice in writing in the
Words and Figures following -

Sir, You are hereby required to take Notice, that
in pursuance of an Act passed in the second
and third year of his present Majesty, entitled
An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively
in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and
eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty
King George the Fourth providing for the Establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make
such Compositions permanent I Lynden Bolton
of Minkstown Castle in the County of Dublin
Esquire being Seignior in fee simple of all that
more the Cahods of Ballinasthano bounded on the
North by Ballycoursey on the South by
Ballyhale on the West by Ballymacdonagh
and on the East by Clonmore situated in the
Parish of Ballyhastard Barony of Ballinaghkeen
and County of Wickford or otherwise in the
according to the provisions of said Act, to agree for
and undertake the payment of the Composition
for Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect
of such Lands to hereby signify to you my desire
to agree for and undertake the future payment
of such Composition as aforesaid, for and in
respect of said Lands; And I hereby require
you to grant me a Certificate, in writing,
confirmable to the provisions of said Act, declaring
me entitled to the benefit of this Notice and to
perform the other Matters on your part required by
said Act to be done - Dated 24th day of October 1834
