passed in Ireland in the Eleventh and Twelfth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Third entitled "an Act for Erecting
and making such Chapels and those that are already erected perpetual Cures and for making a proper provision for the maintenance of the same
for making Appropriate Parishes Perpetual Cures" Thomas by Divine permission Late Lord Bishop of Lighthelm and Ferns did by
the Consent of the Reverend ^{Richard} Radcliffe late Incumbent of the Rectory and Vicarage of Saint Mary's Enniscorthy under his Hand and Seal
Townlands to be comprized within a distinct or new Parish to belong to the Cure of a certain new Church or Chapel to be a perpetual Cure within
the said Bishop with the consent aforesaid did by deed duly Registered and Enrolled and bearing date the fourteenth day of April One
appoint the several and respective Townlands of Ballyencorseymore, Ballycoursyleeg, Cooladine, Killeahy, Ballinastraw, Ballybeg, Bannally,
Ballynoleg, Anafin, Mount Daniel, Kiltide, Ballymurray, Keenagoragh, Ballinamudeta, Middleton, Oulartleigh, Clannore, Bally
Parish of Ballyhuskard and also the Townlands of Kiltowish, Cortally, Conganore and Kilpene in the Parish of Templeshannon part of the
of which said Townlands are situate in the Diocese aforesaid and then being within the Rectory and Vicarage of Saint Mary's Enniscorthy to belong
of Killeahy and known by the name of the perpetual Curacy of Ballyhuskard aforesaid bounded as in said deed mentioned and
for the purposes in said Act mentioned saving to the said Incumbent and his Successors all his and their Rights as Incumbents of
and Enrollment will appear **And whereas** afterwards the said Walter Greene was pursuant to the said Act, duly nominated by the
late Bishop to be licensed by him as perpetual Curate of the said perpetual Curacy of Ballyhuskard aforesaid, and the said Bishop did
and the said Walter Greene is now perpetual Curate thereof duly nominated, appointed and licensed **And whereas** by the said
that if the Rector or Incumbent of the Parish without such perpetual Curate should be called or his Successors should be called in writing with the
of the Diocese or their Successors the Patrons of the Parish and the Dean and Chapter of the Diocese, where there is a Dean and Chapter, testifying
writing Endowing such Curate with a competent portion of Glebe or tithes for the maintenance of the Curate who should be endowed, such writing
therefor to be discharged from the payment of a salary to the said Curate who should be so endowed, such writing to be prepared in the
the Chancery of this Kingdom **And whereas** the said John Whitley Stokes is now Incumbent of the said Rectory and Vicarage
and the said Walter Greene and his Successors perpetual Curates of the said perpetual Curacy of Ballyhuskard with the Tithes
the Towns and Lands of Ballynolegmore, Derry, Kiltide, Ballymurray and Keenagoragh containing Seven hundred and Eighty Eight
now by estimation of the Yearly Value of One hundred pounds Sterling or thereabouts, and also with the Glebe Land commonly called the Glebe
Ballynastraw in the said Parish of Ballyhuskard containing by estimation twenty Acres or thereabouts (late Whitley Stokes)
