Bullinacree as of and upon at a special Vestry held
for that purpose is there received and by some of
the same shall go and be for the Medical Office
and one hundred and fifty three pounds six shillings
and eight pence for the vicarage of the crops of the
Parish of Bullinacree for the year ending

Lefty pound fifty annually which sum
is due and payable to the Vicar and Curate of the same
as a compensation for the Vicarage of the same
as Rector and Vicar of said Parish -

And we do further certify that the average
price of Wheat being then (over) generally grown
in said County for the period of seven years
previous to and ending on the 1st of Nov 1871
is £ 1 18 8/8 per Borel -
