OBSERVATIONS

TO ALL whom these Presents shall come, I the Revd. Henry Maxwell Incumbent of the Parish of Ballymacormick in the County of Longford send Greeting, WHEREAS John R. Robinson Esqr. Agent to Mrs. Jessop in the County of Longford has truly served me with a Notice in Writing in the Words and Figures following,

SIR, - You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled, an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for establishing of COMPOSITION of TITHES in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, I John B Robinson Agent to Mrs. Jessop of Lergtassick in the County of Longford being Agent to Mrs. Jessop of All That and Those, the land of Knockattary situate In the parish of Ballymacormick Boundary's are as Such ciz. On the North by Ballinmon on the south by Knockagun in the Parish of Killcormick and on the west by Ards in the same parish and on the east by the lands of Brickans in the same parish situate in the Parish of Ballymacormick Barony of \_\_\_\_\_ and County of Longford or otherwise entitled, according to the Provisions of said Act, to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of such Lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of such Composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant me a Certificate in Writing, conformable to the Provisions of said Act, declaring her Ladyship entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.

Agent Acting for and on Behalf of Mrs. Jessop is entitled to the benefit of such Notice, pursuant to the Provisions of the said Act, so far as relates to the several Lands and Premises in said Notice mentioned, and charged with the Composition for Tithes for said Parish, and which Lands are more particularly set forth in the Map hereunto annexed.
