I John Connor Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 4th of Geo. 4th 2^d of M^{ch} 4th for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the parish of Ballymanney in the County of Kildare do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish is Forty pounds late Irish Currency or thirty six pounds eighteen shillings & five pence British by the year which sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Mr. Arthur Maguire Rector of Kildash as aforesaid as a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him as owner of the Rectorial Tithes - I further Certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in the County for the period of seven years ending 1st Novr 1830 is at the rate of £1.12⁰/₁₀ per Barrel -
