

We the Rev. John Meade and Thomas Henrick Esq.
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by virtue of an act made in the Fourth year of the
reign of King George the Fourth entitled an act to
provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland for a limited Time, to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes, arising,
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Ballymartle in the County of Cork, do hereby certify
that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Four Hundred and sixty Pounds ^{Stg.} by the year.

And we do further certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally sown
in such County for the Period of seven years
ending on the first day of November 1821. is
One Pound Eighteen Shillings and Eight Pence
halfpenny per Bushell.
