

It is a General Session of the peace holden
at Cork for the East riding of the County of Cork
pursuant to the provisions of an act passed in the
fourth year of the reign of his late Majesty King
George the fourth on the twentieth day of September
in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty six
before John Marley Assistant Barrister of
the said riding and other Justice assigned to
Keep the Peace in the County of Cork and of
the quorum and of forth -

Be it remembered that William Henry Perick William
Richard Mease Thomas Perick and John Lane owners and occupiers
of land in the Parish of Ballymattle in the East riding of the
County of Cork charges respectively with the payment of Three
pence tithing and appears annually in respect of the composition
for the tithes of said Parish have duly filed in this Court an
application in writing having previously given due notice of their
intention so to do by posting such notice signed by them for two
successive Sundays the last being eight clear days before the
first day of this present Session of the Peace in the principal
outer door of the parish Church of said Parish to us here in this
present Session assembled for the purpose of varying for the
Ensuing three years and until further order the amount
of composition ascertain'd to be payable for the tithes of said
Parish by the Certificate of Commissioners duly appointed for
that purpose under the provisions of the fourth George the fourth
Chapter 99 and bearing date the twenty third day of March
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four
and to vary the apportionment and assessment for the said Parish
made in conformity to said Certificate by said Commissioners
and in pursuance of said notice and for the purpose of certifying
the matter of the said application the Incumbent of the said
Parish solely entitled to the tithes thereof has also appeared
before us here and has consented to the same and to the
subsequent proceedings thereupon taken and the said Certificate
having set forth that wheat is the grain principally grown in
the said County of Cork and that one pound eighteen shillings
and eight pence of the late Currency is the average price of the
quicker for the seven years preceding the first day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four
being equal to one pound fifteen shillings and eight pence of
the present Currency We have in conformity to the power to us
by the said last mentioned act given referred to Ezekiel
We here as an arbitrator to report in writing the average
amount of the prices of good Marketable Wheat for the
seven years immediately preceding the time of said application
and the said Ezekiel in writing under his hands having
reported to us the average price of good Marketable wheat
for the seven years preceding the time of the said application
is one pound seven shillings and three pence present
Currency and the difference between those averages being
more than one tenth We the Justices in said Session
assembled do therefore order and adjudge that the
amount of Composition in said original Certificate set forth
as the composition payable for the tithes of said Parish
