" Parliament passed in the second year of the reign  
" of the present Majesty, entitled

" An act to amend three acts passed res-  
" pectively in the fourth fifth and the seventh  
" and eighth years of the reign of His late Majesty  
" King George the fourth providing for the  
" establishing of compositions for tithes  
" in Scotland and to make such composi-  
" tions permanent and of agreeing for and  
" undertaking the future payment of all com-  
" positions in lieu of tithes arising from or  
" out of the lands therein after mentioned or  
" referred to do hereby give notice signifying  
" that such is my claim I have annexed  
" hereto a Schedule describing by metes and  
" bounds the land charged or chargeable  
" with such composition viz

" Metelt Hill, Curran track, Gortone  
" village, Prospect, Ballynecloughy, part of  
" Kilmartin, Corragh, Maysoon, Paulbrain  
" Parkmore, Parkbeg, Dotty, East Sawine  
" all which lands are in the Parish of  
" Ballinacourt, and are bounded on the
