Twenty five pounds by the year of which sum  
One Hundred & Sixty two pounds ten Shillings  
are half the amount thereof are due & payable to  
George Sugut and James Hudson Sen. Esqrs. as Lessees  
to the Vicars Choral of Christ Church in the City of  
Dublin, The owners of the Rectorial Tithes of said  
Parish, as a composition for the Tithes claimable by  
them; And the remaining half of said sum amounting  
to One Hundred and sixty two pounds ten Shillings  
is due and payable to the Rev. Joseph Neuchayle the  
Vicar as owner of the Vicarial Tithes of said Parish.
