of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishing  
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a  
true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Ballinahughish in the County of Mayo do hereby certify  
that the true and just amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the said  
Parish is Three Hundred and Twenty five Pounds Sterling by the Year: Of  
which Sum One Hundred and Sixty two Pounds ten Shillings being one half  
the amount thereof are due and payable to George Sneyt and James Anderson  
(Sen<sup>r</sup>) Esq<sup>rs</sup> as lessees to the Vicar & Choral of Christ Church in the City of Dublin  
the owners of the Rectorial Tithe of said Parish as a Composition for the Tithe  
claimable by them: And the remaining half of said Sum amounting to One  
Hundred and Sixty two Pounds ten Shillings Sterling is due and payable  
to the Reverend Joseph Wychogle the Vicar as owner of the Vicarial Tithe  
of said Parish

— And W<sup>ch</sup> do further certify that the average price of oats being the  
Corn principally grown in said Parish and County for the Period of Seven Years  
ending on the first day of November 1821 twenty one is Fifteen Shillings and two  
pence farthings per Barrel
