We Francis Lynch Blane and John Lynch duly
Appointed Commissioners & sworn, under & by virtue of
an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George
the fourth intitled 'an Act for the establishing of Compositions
and for Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time to ascertain
of the true & just Composition for all tithes arising from
any, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Ballymore in
the County of Mayo, do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is one hundred and sixty two pounds by
the Year of which sum of one hundred and sixty two pounds
Twenty three pounds five Shillings & two pence three farthings
being two thirds part of the tithes arising from the lands the
property of the See of Tuam in the said County Parish are
due & payable to the Revd James Dunne as a Composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Prebendary of Bally
more & we do further Certify that the average price of Oats
being the Corn chiefly grown in said County for the
period of seven years ending on the first day of Novem-
ber one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is fifteen
Shillings and two pence one farthing for Oats by the barrel late
currency.
