*Certificate of Composition for the Tithes of the  
Parish of Ballyowly.*

We Francis Lynch Blossie and John Lynch duly  
appointed Commissioners and sworn under and by  
virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign  
of King George the Fourth intitled "An Act for the  
5 establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just  
Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded  
or payable within the parish of Ballyowly in the  
10 County of Mayo (do hereby certify that the true and  
just amount of Composition for all tithes  
whatevver within the said Parish is £162. by the  
year of which sum of £162. £= 23. 5. 2 $\frac{3}{4}$  being  
two thirds part of the Tithes arising from the  
15 Lands the property of the see of Tuam in the said  
Parish are due and payable to the Rev James Dunne  
as Prebendary of Killybeggs and we do further  
that the average price of oats being the corn chiefly  
20 grown in said County for the period of seven years  
ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 1821 is 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  $\frac{1}{4}$  for  
Oats by the barrel late currency.
