Hullallee Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of a let  
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth intituled "in act to  
provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time" is as certain and free a true and just composition for all vicarial tithes  
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Ballypatric in the  
County of Mayo To wit that a true and just composition for all  
vicarial tithes what ever within the said Parish is Two hundred and nine  
Pounds Six Shillings Sixpence by the year which said sum of Two hundred and  
nine Pounds Six Shillings Sixpence is due and payable to the Reverend Joseph  
Worschelle a Vicar of said Parish of Ballypatric as a composition for the  
the vicarial tithes as before of the vicarial tithes of said Parish

And it is further Obedy that the average price of oats being the  
best principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending  
on the first day of November 1821 was 16 Shillings and two pence farthings  
per barrel
