"time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for
all Ecclesiastical tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the parish of Bellshill in the county of Ayr do
hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition
for all Ecclesiastical tithes whatsoever within the said parish
is one hundred and seventy five pounds seven shillings and
eight pence farthing British Sterling by the year which
said sum of one hundred and seventy five pounds seven
shillings and eight pence farthing is due and Payable
to the Reverend and very Hon^{ble} George Gore Dean
of the Deanery of Millhall as a composition for the
tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish
And W^c do further certify that the average price of
oats being the corn principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending on
the first day of November 1821 was sixteen
shillings and two pence farthing per Bussell
