growing, growing or payable within the parish of Dullinahilly in the County of Down
Do hereby certify that a true and just Composition for all Vicarial tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Two hundred and nine Pounds six Shillings Sterling by
the year; which said Sum of Two hundred and nine Pounds six Shillings Sterling is
due and payable to the Reverend Joseph Verschoyle as Vicar of said Parish of
Dullinahilly as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar of
the Vicarial tithes of said Parish

— And We do further certify that the average price of Sals being the Corn
principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on
the first day of November 1821 was fifteen Shillings and two pence farthings
per bushel
