virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the of the reign of  
King George the fourth substituted an act to provide for the  
"Establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited  
"time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all  
Rectorial tithes arising growing yielded or payable within  
the parish of Ballinacree in the county of Mayo do hereby  
Certify that the true and just amount of composition for  
all Rectorial tithes whatever within the said parish is  
one hundred and seventy five pounds seven shillings  
and eight pence farthing British Sterling by the year  
which said sum of one hundred and seventy five pounds  
seven shillings and eight pence farthing is due and  
Payable to the Honourable and very Reverend George  
Lyne Dean of the Treasury of Millalla as a composition  
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said  
Parish and WE do further certify that ~~the~~  
the average price of oats being the corn principally  
grown in such county for the period of seven years  
ending on the first day of November 1824 one is  
seven shillings and two pence farthing per barrel

Done at Millalla this 24<sup>th</sup>  
Day of August 1826
