


Certificate of Composition for the Parish of
Ballyscaddane in the County of Simcock & in the
Diocese of Emly

William Gubbins Commissioner duly appointed & sworn unto & by virtue of
an act made in the second & third years of the reign of King William the fourth
Intituled an act to amend those acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth
& in the seventh & eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George
the fourth Providing for the establishing of composition for tithes in Ireland
& to make such compositions permanent To ascertain & fix a true & just compo-
sition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable, within the Parish of
Ballyscaddane in the County of Simcock & in the Diocese of Emly, I do hereby certify
that the true & just amount of composition for all tithes whatsover within the
said Parish of Ballyscaddane is Forty pounds twelve shillings &
Six pence by the year which sum is due and payable to the very Rev.
Thomas Philip Lejane Dean of Emly as a composition for the tithes co-
llectable by him as Rector of said parish of Ballyscaddane.

And I do further certify the average price
of oats being the ear principally grown in such County for the period of
seven years ending on the thirty first day of October one thousand eight
hundred & thirty is Twelve shillings & seven pence half penny Per
Bunel
