I Christopher Reynold Commissioner having been duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, Intituled an Act to amend three Acts, passed respectively in the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and eight years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent and by virtue of said Act to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising, growing, belonging to, yielded or payable within the Parish of Balraghgan and County of Wick.

Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Balraghgan is one Hundred and sixty one Pounds

And I do further Certify that the said sum of one Hundred and sixty one Pounds is due and payable to the Rev. William Bylmer as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish of Balraghgan.
