duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue  
of an Act made in the fourth of the reign of King  
George the Fourth Chap 99. intituled to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all  
tithe arising growing yielding or payable with  
in the parish of Walsath Raynes in the County  
of Meath. do hereby certify that the true and  
just amount of composition for all tithes  
whatever within the said parish is Two Hundred  
and Seventy Seven pounds Sterling the year of which  
are due and payable to the Reverend Thomas  
De Lacy Archdeacon of Meath and Rector of said  
Parish. And we do further certify that the Average  
price of Wheat being the corn principally grown in such  
County for the period of Seven years ending on the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 is one pound eighteen  
Shillings and eight pence half penny per Barrell;  
and that the Average price of Oats being the corn  
principally grown in such county for the period  
of Seven years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November  
1821 is Fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing per  
Barrell - dated this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April 1827
