and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whatsoever within the said parish is Two Hundred
and Seventy seven pounds sterling, by the year, of which
sum are due and payable to the Reverend Thomas
De Lacy Archdeacon of Meath and Rector of said
parish, And we do further certify that the
Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
=ally grown in such County for the period of seven
years ending on the 1st day of November 1821 is
One pound Eighteen Shillings and eight pence
halfpenny per Barrell and that the Average
price of Oats being ~~the~~ Corn principally grown
in such County for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st day of November 1821 is fifteen
Shillings and two pence farthing per Barrell
dated this 21st day of April 1827
