duly appointed and sworn under, and by virtue
of an Act made in the Fourth of the reign of
King George the Fourth Chap. 99 intituled to
ascertain and fix a true & just composition
for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable
within the Parish of Culbally Bogne in the County
of Meath, do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said parish is Two Hun-
dred and Seventy seven pounds Sterg by the
year of which are due and payable to the
Reverend Thomas De Lacy Archdeacon of Meath
and Rector of said Parish. And we do further
certify that the Average price of Wheat being
the Corn principally grown in such County
for the period of seven years ending on the
1st day of November 1821 is One pound
Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence half
penny per Barrell. and that the Average
price of Oats being the Corn principally
in such County for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st day of November 1821 is
Fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing
per Barrell dated this 21st day of
April 1827
