OBSERVATIONS.

I Gerrard Edward Strickland sole commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 2nd & 3rd year of the reign of King William the fourth entitled "an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the 14th & 5th and 7th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition of all tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Recan and County of Mayo do hereby certify that the true and just amount for all tithes ^{whenever} within the said parish is one hundred and twenty seven pounds eight shillings and five pence farthing by the year, of which sum of one hundred and twenty seven pounds eight shillings and five pence farthing the whole is due and payable to the Rector of the said parish.

And I further certify that the average price of oats being the grain principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1831 (one) is twelve shillings and eleven pence half penny per barrel -
