Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the 5th Parish of Bunniew in the
Co. Wickford - Do hereby Certify, that the true & just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the 5th Parish is, Three Hundred, & thirty
five Pounds, five shillings & seven Pence by the
Year, of which Sum of 395-5-7 One Hundred, &
sixty five Pounds, five Shillings & seven Pence, are due
& payable to the Rev^d William Turkey, as a Composition
for the Tithes ^{accruable} payable by him, as Vicar of the 5th Pa-
rish, & that Two Hundred & thirty Pounds are
due & payable to Caesar Colclough Esq^r. as Lay
Impropriator of the 5th Parish. -
And we do further Certify, that the average
price of Oats, being the chief principally grown
