

Ballinglahy, 27th October 1824

We Wm P. Higginsbotham and Richard Tenter, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the 4th "intituled" an act to provide for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" do ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Ballinglahy in the County of Wicklow do certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish is Six hundred and seventy pounds by the year the entire of which sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Wm Progan as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as rector of the said parish -

And we do further certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1821 is 15²/₂ p^{er} Barrel.
