Amount of Composition for all Tythes what-
ever within the said Parish is Two Hundred
and thirty five Pounds by the Year. of
which sum of £ 235:0:0. one half belongs
to the Hon^{ble} & Rev^d Wm Beauford as Vicar
of said Parish and the other half to the Very
Rev^d Thomas Carter Dean of Tuam as
Rector of said Parish. - Given under our
hands this 6th day of August 1827.
