composition for all tithes arising growing yielded and
payable within the Parish of Birr in the Kings County
do hereby certify that the Right Honorable The Earl of
Rosse Chairman of a special Vestry under and by virtue
of said Act has certified to us that it was agreed by
and between the Reverend Abraham Downes Clerk Rector
of said Parish and the Parishioners thereof that he
the said Abraham Downes would receive and that
they the said Parishioners would pay to him and his
successors the annual sum of three hundred pounds for
all Tithes in said Parish payable to the Rector thereof
and that the Right Reverend Alexander Lord Bishop
of Kildaloe as Bishop of the Diocese and Patron of said
Parish had assented to such agreement and that the
Parishioners of said Parish at a special Vestry holden
under
