under the title of an Act made in the 2d Year of the reign of his
present Majesty King William 4th Entitled An Act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 5th 11th & 18th years of the reign of
his late Majesty King George the 4th for providing for the settling
of compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions
permanent. As certain Acts & just compositions for all Tithes arising
growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Blectraath, Diocese of
Down & County of Wick, do hereby certify that the true & just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within said Parish is One
Hundred & nineteen pounds & nine pence ~~by~~ by the year due &
payable to the Rev. G. Gilbert Rectore as Rector & Vicar of
said Parish.

And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in said County is £1.12.0/2
per Bushel for the period of seven years ending on the 1st day
of Novr. 1830 (thirty)
