ons for tythes in Ireland for a limited time,
Do hereby certify that We have appointed the
sum of Two thousand and fifty pounds Brit-
ish currency equal to two thousand and thirty
pounds sixteen shillings and four pence half penny
British currency - which the Comptroller is entitled to
receive as Compensation for tythes in said just
and equitable proportions according to the
value of the land, to the best of his skill and
judgment, which proportions are correct,
stated in the foregoing account opposite to the
names of each estate in -
