Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and
by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the
Reign King George the Fourth, entitled "An Act
to provide for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time," do ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all
tithes arising growing yielded or payable within
the Parish of Britway in the County of Cork, do
hereby certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Two hundred and Ninety
Seven pounds five shillings and three half pence
per year - the Tithes of which sum of
Two hundred and Ninety seven pounds five
shillings and three half pence is due and paya-
ble to the Rev^d Andrew Dawson Rector of
said Parish of Britway as a Composition for
the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the
said Parish -

And We do further certify that the average
price of Wheat in the Corn principally
grown in the East Riding of the County of Cork
for the period of seven years, ending on the
first day of November one thousand eight hun-
dred and twenty one is one pound eighteen
shillings and eight pence half penny, as ascertained
from under our hands this thirteenth
day of October 1823 & twenty three -
