Commissioners by the Rector and Parishioners of  
Britway in the Baronies of Barrymore and  
Kinnataloon County of Cork and Diocese of Cloyne  
in vestry assembled by virtue of the act of Parliament  
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King  
George the Fourth ch. 97 - and in the Fifth year  
of the Reign of King George the Fourth ch. 63  
"Entitled an act to provide for the Establishing of  
"Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a  
"limited time" - do hereby certify we have  
apportioned the sum of Two hundred and fifty  
Pounds late Irish currency equal to Two  
Hundred and thirty Pounds fifteen shillings  
and four pence in British Currency,  
which the Rector is entitled to receive as Com-  
position for Tythes in fair just and equitable  
proportions according to the value of the Land, to  
the best of our Skill and Judgement, which  
Proportions are correctly stated in the foregoing  
account opposite to the names of each occupier.
