To prove that he was employed in the years 1820, 1829, 1830 & 1831 to Value the Tithes of Binn.

He will prove that in 1820 on his first going into the Parishes he discovered that a system of treating and Whiskey drinking prevailed to a very great extent & that in each case where a drink was given it followed as a necessary consequence that the Valuations was reduced.

In 1829 Bribing was carried on and it became quite general through every part of the Parish. - He will prove that amongst those from whom he received Bribes (and distributed their propositions to the other two Valuers Wm Browne & Mick Collins) were the following viz -
