

And the said distribution of the Patronage thereof do take effect from and after the first day of May instant, And Whereas it appears unto us that the Reverend *Thomas Stuart* Townsend the present Incumbent of the said Union of Burnchurch has paid to the Representatives of his Predecessor a sum of £2317 : 5 : 7- for building a Globe House and other Improvements in said Union, and it appears to us just and reasonable that a sum of £1335 : 6 : 4½ portion thereof being equivalent to two years income of the Benefice of Burnchurch hereby constituted should be chargeable and charged upon the said Benefice as hereby created, and that the residue thereof being a sum of £981 : 19 : 2 - should be charged upon and distributed amongst the Parishes to be augmented as set forth in said recited instrument. **Now We** the said Lord Lieutenant and Council as aforesaid do hereby further order and direct that the said Reverend *Thomas Stuart* Townsend the said Incumbent of the said Union of Burnchurch be entitled to receive and shall receive from his next successor the sum of £1001 : 9 : 9½, and no more, being three fourths of said sum of £1335 : 6 : 4½, and that his Successor having paid the same, shall receive from his next successor chargeable the sum of £667 : 13 : 2¼, and no more, being two thirds of the sum so paid by him, and that his Successor having paid said sum shall receive from his next successor chargeable the sum of £333 : 16 : 7- and no more, being one half of the sum so paid by him, all which said sums shall be paid and payable to such Incumbents or their Successors or to their Representatives respectively at such respective times, and in such manner as the said sums or any of them would have been respectively payable by virtue of any Law or Statute in force in Ireland, and be recoverable by such means and proceedings as the same would have been recoverable if the dissolution of the said Union had not taken place, or this Act had not been made. And with respect to the difference between the said sum of £1335 : 6 : 4½, and the sum of £2317 : 5 : 7- paid by the present Incumbent to his Predecessor, amounting to the sum of £981 : 19 : 2 - **We** further order and direct, that the said last mentioned sum be repaid to said Incumbent or his Representatives by the several Incumbents of the Parishes augmented by this our Order in proportion to the values of the additions made to them respectively, as follows, that is to say, - That the Incumbent of the parish of Ennisnag shall pay the sum of £108 : 16 : 10 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Thomastown shall pay the sum of £112 : 14 : 2 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Innistoge shall pay the sum of £192 : 9 : 5 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Listerlin shall pay the sum of £53 : 12 : 6 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Killeacon shall pay the sum of £113 : 6 : 6 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Clonmore shall pay the sum of £77 : 11 : 11 - That the Incumbent of the parish of Aghour shall pay the sum of £121 : 14 : 2 - and that the Incumbent of the parish of Odogh shall pay the sum of £201 : 13 : 8 - and that the said several sums shall be paid and payable to the Incumbent of Burnchurch the said Reverend *Thomas Stuart* Townsend or his Representatives by the Incumbents of the said several Parishes respectively in four equal Payments as follows that is to say, the first Payment thereof to be made on or before the 31st day of December 1850 - the second on or before the 30th day of June 1851 - the third on or before the 31st day of December 1851, and the fourth, on or before the 30th day of June 1852, and that none of the said Incumbents shall have any claim upon their respective Successors for any portion of the sums so to be paid by them respectively - But that such Payments having been made to the said Reverend *Thomas Stuart* Townsend the present Incumbent of Burnchurch or his Representatives, that the said sum or charge of £981 : 19 : 2, shall be and the same is hereby declared to be extinct, **Provided nevertheless**

That
