

the Parishes aforesaid before the 31st day of December, 1851, the portion of the charge upon that Parish which is to be paid next after the change takes place shall be borne by the Incumbents in the proportion in which the rent-charge for the half year is to be divided between them. And Whereas a sum of £572:4:5 remains due on foot of a loan, ^{made} by the late Board of First Fruits in aid towards building the Glebe House of the Union of Burnchurch, and is repayable by annual instalments of £24:10:6 to the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for Ireland, to whom all sums formerly due and payable to the Trustees of First Fruits are now payable by law, we do further order and direct that the said sum of £572:4:5 & shall be charged and chargeable wholly upon the newly constituted Benefice of Burnchurch as here by defined; and that the said annual instalments shall be paid and payable by the present Incumbent and his successors at the same times and in the same manner to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, and that the same shall be recoverable by them, as the same would be payable and recoverable if the Union of Burnchurch as heretofore existing had not been dissolved.

And We do hereby Order and Direct that this Order shall come into operation, and take effect from and immediately after the first day of May, 1850: Provided always, that this instrument, with a copy of the Ordinance Sheets referred to therein, and marked and coloured as aforesaid, be enrolled in the Rolls Office of Her Majesty's High Court of Chancery in Ireland within six months from the date hereof, else to be void and of no effect: And Provided also that a copy of said instrument with such Ordinance Sheets marked and coloured as aforesaid be deposited in the Registry Office of the said Diocese of Ossory within such period of six months: of which all persons concerned are hereby required to take notice.
