"Cahera" in the County of Cork. Do hereby Certify that the
true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is Six Hundred and fifty Pounds British by the
year - the whole of which sum is due and payable to the
Rev. Richard L. Wells, as Rector of the said Parish

And We do further Certify that the average
Price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County
for the Period of Seven Years ending the first day of November 1841
is £ 1. 18. 8 1/2 -
