

in the County of Cork did certify under their hands that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes within that part of said Parish consisting of the several denominations of land hereinafter mentioned that is to say the Ploughlands of Ballybrack Ballymee Ballymague Ballidaniel East Ballidaniel West Caherduggan Cahwmeen Clogueen Cloughaneery Keelmacoomb Kilburn Lag and Two plot house was Two hundred and eighty pounds by the year which sum was due and payable to Charles Penham Orlando Sephton Esquire as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him out of said mentioned lands as say Improvisor of said Parish And further that the average price of oats being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending the First day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one was fourteen shillings per barrel.

And Whereas the Tithe Composition and the Rent charge payable in lieu thereof in said Parish have since been apportioned and paid according to the amount in said Certificate self forth and without variation.

And Whereas William Lyngate Esquire Farmer P. Spratt Esquire and Margaret Carroll being three persons in said parts of said Parish of Caherduggan each charged with the annual

payment of three pounds sterling and upwards in respect of the rent charge now payable in said parts of said Parish in lieu of said Tithe Composition caused a notice in writing signed by each of them to be duly affixed and published within said Parish in the manner prescribed by the Statutes to that intent made and provided on two successive Sundays that is to say on Sunday the Twentieth day of September one thousand eight hundred and ninety six and on Sunday the Twentyseventh day of September one thousand eight hundred and ninety six signifying their intent to apply and that they would apply to the Justices of the Peace for the County of Cork assembled at the next ensuing General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County that is to say the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held at Cork in and for said County and in and for Cork County East Riding and (being the County and Riding in which said Parish is situate) on the Twentythird day of October one thousand eight hundred and ninety six to have the average price of oats being the corn in said original Certificate of said John C. Braddell and John Mahony mentioned for the seven years preceding inquired of and ascertained from the Dublin Gazette in order that the amount of said Tithe Composition and the Rent charge now payable in lieu thereof
