

Amount of Composition for tithes of the Parish of Coleraine being a part of the perpetual Union of Saint John  
in the Diocese of Elphin in the County of Sligo, as ascertained by William Laugel and Robt. Loran Esqrs  
Commissioners appointed by Virtue of an Act 4<sup>th</sup> George the 4<sup>th</sup> Chap: 99 and the same being payable  
as follows 1<sup>st</sup> to the Present Vicar and Chairman of the Cathedral Church of the Holy and Undivided  
Trinity & Saint Patrick, Dublin, One Hundred and Seventy Pounds fifteen Shillings and nine  
Pence halfpenny, and to the Rev. Charles Hamilton Rector of the said Union, One Hundred  
and Twenty Five Pounds, fifteen Shillings and nine pence halfpenny, making in the whole  
the sum of Three Hundred and fifty three Pounds, Eleven Shillings and four pence the 2<sup>nd</sup> by  
the Year, as the average price of Oats taken from the Dublin Gazette for the seven years  
ending the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1821 being 15<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 1/4 Barrels of 14 Stone. We have also by the  
Assessment of Appointments for the said Composition of £353. 11. 7 ascertained and fixed the just  
and fair sum to be paid and levied from each Landholder in said Parish, according to the  
quality and quantity of their Land, which is put down in figures and written in words in line  
with each persons Name and Land, and by the Authority vested in us we authorize the Col-  
-lection of said Composition accordingly. Given under our Hands the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1824
