

At a Special Vestry held in the Parish of
Cappagh pursuant to Notice duly posted under
and by Virtue of the Acts for establishing Compo^s
for Tithes in Ireland and said Vestry having duly
assembled pursuant to said Notice on Tuesday the
Twenty second day of April One Thousand eight
Hundred and Twenty eight there being more
than seven Vestry Men present.

Resolved that John Peppard Esq^r be and he
is hereby appointed Chairman of this Vestry.

It is hereby agreed between the Parishioners
assembled at said Vestry to give to the Incumbent
of the Parish of Cappagh The Very Rev Arthur
John Preston and the Successors in said Parish
a Sum of Ninety five pounds Ster in lieu and
satisfaction of all the Tithes growing or to be
grown in said Parish as a Composition for
said Tithes in said Parish for a Term of
Twenty one years from the first day of
November next ensuing the date hereof
and that the same shall be paid and
payable pursuant to the provisions of
the Acts of the 4th of Geo the 4th Chap 99 and
5th of Geo the 4th Ch 63 entitled An Act for
Providing for the Establishment of Compo^s
for Tithes in Ireland. And we do further
