King George intituled "An Act to provide for the Es-
-tablishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded
or payable within the Parish of Cappagh in the County
of Limerick, do hereby certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is Ninety five Pounds by the year, which
sum of Ninety five pounds is due and payable to the
Very Reverend. Father John Preston Dean of Limerick
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as
Rector of said Parish.

And we do further certify that
the average price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven years,
ending on the first day of November 1824 is fifteen
Shillings and two Pence farthing per Barrel.
