

We Josiah Crampton and Cecil Crampton Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the
fourth intituled An Act to provide for the establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Carquin in the County of Galway do hereby
certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for
all Tithes whatsover within the said Parish is one hundred
and twelve pounds three shillings and three halfpence
by the year, of which Sum of one hundred and twelve
pounds three shillings and three halfpence, one half is
due and payable to the Rector as a Composition for the
Tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish, and
one half is due and payable to the Rev John Mcnara
the Vicar.

And we do further certify that, The Average Price
of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the Period of seven years ending on the first day
of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty
one, is thirty eight Shillings and eight pence halfpenny
per Barrel.

And we do further certify that we have increased the
Amount of such Composition beyond the Average Amount
of such Tithes during the seven years preceding the first
day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
by adding to the said Average Amount the Sum of
Four pounds three shillings and seven pence halfpenny
in consequence of Losses sustained by Neglect or Misma-
nagement in the year one thousand eight hundred and
sixteen.
