

Dublin Castle 20<sup>th</sup> October 1825

Gentlemen

Whereas by an Act passed in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of His present Majesty's Reign entitled "An Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions of Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" it is among other things enacted, that in cases where it shall happen that there shall not be any Church Warden in any Parish, then all matters by said Act to be done by or with relation to the Church Wardens of any such Parish shall and may be lawfully done by or with relation to any one or more persons or persons to be for that purpose nominated and appointed as and in law and instead of Church Wardens or Church Wardens of and for such Parish by Order of the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland in case such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors shall think fit so to do, in the application of the Ecclesiastical Incumbent of such Parish for such purposes, and all Acts matters and things done and performed under said Act by or with Relation to any such person so to be nominated and appointed is in law and instead of a Church Warden shall be as to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the same were done and performed by the Church Wardens or Church Warden of any Parish duly appointed according to Law.
