

Tithe Compositions

J Silvester Rait having been duly appointed and sworn
Commissiner under and by virtue of an Act made in the
fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth
entituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and by virtue of an
Act, passed in the second and third years of the Reign of His
Majesty King William the Fourth entituled an Act to amend
three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in
the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty
King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent, and
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising
growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Carrick
in the County of Wicklow, Do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is one hundred and forty nine
Pounds sixteen shillings & one penny halfpenny
by the year of which sum forty nine Pounds
eighteen shillings & eight pence halfpenny
or one third are due and payable to the Rev Charles Palmer as
a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as owner of the
Vicarial Tithe and that two thirds or the sum of
Ninety nine pounds seventeen
shillings and five pence are due and
payable to the Marchioness and Marquis of Downshire as a Com=
=position for the Tithes claimable by them as Lay Impropriators
