by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the  
reign of King George the fourth and an amendment  
thereof made in the fifth, and another amendment  
made in the seventh and eighth years of said reign  
entitled an act to provide for the establishing of Com-  
positions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to  
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
tithes arising growing due or payable within the  
parish of Calingohane partly in the County and partly  
in the County of the City of Cork. Do hereby Certify  
that the true and just <sup>amount of</sup> Composition for all tithes  
whatsoever within the said Parish is Three hundred  
and thirty pounds  $\text{£}330$

by the year payable to the Reverend Henry Theophilus  
Moore Hodder, as Rector of said parish pursuant  
to an agreement entered into by the said H. T. Moore  
Hodder, and a Special vestry of said parish.

AND we do further Certify that the average  
price of oats being the Corn principally sown in said  
Counties for the period of Seven years ending the first  
day of November One thousand eight hundred and  
twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence farthings  
late Irish Currency per Barrel.
