his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the Estab-
lishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make
such Composition permanent. To ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition of all Tithes arising growing yielding
or payable within the Parish of Carrigdownane in the County
of Cork, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is Ninety Pounds by the year, which
sum of Ninety pounds is due and payable to the
Rev^d. Charles Adams Rector. And I further
Certify that the average price of Wheat being the
corn principally grown in said County, for the
Period of seven years ending on the first day of November
1830 is One Stone Twelve Shillings and one half penny
and one half penny and seven pence half penny
