I James French Commissioner duly appointed  
and sworn, under, and by virtue of an Act passed  
in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the  
Fourth, entitled an Act to provide for the establishing  
of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, for a limited time,  
and by virtue of an Act passed in the second, and  
third, years of the reign of His Majesty King William  
the Fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts  
passed respectively, in the fourth, fifth, and in the  
seventh, and eighth years of the reign of His late  
Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the  
establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and  
to make such compositions, permanent, and to  
ascertain and fix a true, and just composition, for  
all Tithes, arising, growing, yielding, and payable  
within the Parish of Carrigtobill in the County  
of Cork, do hereby certify, that the true and just  
composition, for all Tithes whatever within the said  
Parish is one thousand and thirty five pounds, four  
shillings Sterling, by the year, of which sum of the  
thousand, and thirty five pounds four shillings  
one third part is due and payable to the Reverend  
Henry Johnson, as a composition for the Tithes claim-  
able by him as Vicar of the said Parish, and two thirds  
of said sum are due and payable to Elizabeth Luky  
the elder, Elizabeth Luky the younger, and Giselda  
Luky, being the Representatives of the late George  
Luky Esquire, as a composition for the Tithes claimable  
by them as Lay Impropriators of said Parish.
