

I James French Commissioner duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, "Entituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, for a limited time, and by virtue of an Act passed in the second and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, "Entituled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively, in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh, and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a true and Just Composition for all Tithes arising, Growing, Yielding, and payable within the parish of Rarigtohil, in the County of Cork, do hereby Certify, that the true and Just Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish, is ~~one thousand and thirty five pounds, four shillings,~~ Sterling by the year, of which sum of ~~one thousand and thirty five pounds four shillings,~~ one third part is due, and payable to the Reverend Henry Johnson, as a Composition for the Tithe Claimable by him as Vicar of said parish, and two thirds of said sum
