 Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
 Term to ascertain and for a true and just amount of  
 Compositions for all Tithes arising growing, yielded, or payable  
 within the Parish of Caskole in the County of Longford,  
 do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of  
 Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish  
 is Six Hundred and Sixty four pounds Twelve Shillings  
 and Three pence Sterling by the year. Of which Sum of  
 Six Hundred and Sixty four pounds Twelve Shillings  
 Three pence, Four Hundred and Sixty three pounds  
 One Shilling and Six pence, are due and payable to  
 Richard Armstrong & Constance Armstrong and  
 Richard Armstrong & Sons as a Composition for the  
 Tithes Claimable by them as Lessees under the Long Proprietary  
 and Two Hundred and Twenty one pounds Twelve Shillings  
 and Nine pence, are due and payable to the Reverend  
 R. A. Shuter, the Vicar of said Parish.

And we do further Certify that the average price  
 of Cattle being the best price of any year in said County  
 for the period of seven years ending on the first day of  
 November next is Eighteen Shillings and Three pence per Head
