

Whereas the Notice following has been served by Joseph Salkeld Esq. on me Thomas Webber Clerk, Rector of the Parish of Castle Mcadam Diocese of Dublin

Sir

I hereby give you Notice as Rector or Ecclesiastical Incumbent of the Parish of Castle Mcadam in the Barony of Wicklow in the County of Wicklow, that I am desirous pursuant to the provisions of the Statute of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of William IV. Chap. 119<sup>th</sup> to agree for and undertake the future payment of the Tithe composition which is payable for the tithes, out of my Estate and several townlands of Connore containing 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres Irish plantation Measure or thereabouts, Shroughmore containing 228 acres, Irish plantation measure or thereabouts, Kilmacow containing 401 acres, Irish plantation measure or thereabouts, and Ballinabarney containing 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres, Irish plantation measure or thereabouts, in the above mentioned Parish of Castle Mcadam, and described in a Map or plan herewith annexed, which Estate I hold in fee Simple, and that the Mote and bounds of which said Townlands so charged with said Composition are as follows vizt. on the North, by Newbawn and Bala, on the South by the River Avonmore Tignoney and Cronbanes, on the East, by Kilmacra, Ballykean, Lower Kilmacow, Coolanearl, and Knockree, and on the West, by Newbawn, Rockstown, and the River Avonmore. I have therefore to request that you will furnish me with an account of the sums payable to you out of the said townlands, and also with the Certificate required by the 22<sup>nd</sup> Section of the Above recited, act of Parliament
