

At a Vestry held in the Parish Church of Castlerahan, in the Diocese of Kilmore, and County of Cavan, in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty, for the Commutation of the Tithes of said Parish, of which the Hon. and Very Rev^d Henry Vesey Fitz-Gerald is Rector, it was then and there agreed on, in and by said Vestry, that he, as Rector, should receive, in Commutation for the Tithes of said Parish, the average amount of the seven years next antecedent to the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-one, agreeable to, and by virtue of, an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled "An Act to provide for and Establishing a Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time." We, Thomas Nugent and Edward Plunkett, Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of said Act, do hereby Certify, that the average amount of the next seven years preceding One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-one, agreeable to the Tithe View Books, and other Documents produced or furnished to us, by the Hon. and Very Rev^d Henry Vesey Fitz-Gerald, Rector, and Thomas Heaslip, one of his then Proctors, is Three Hundred and Four Pounds One Shilling, and Ten Pence half penny, sterl., and is the annual true and just amount of Composition, as agreed on, in and by said Vestry, and for all Tithe claimable by him, the said Hon. and Very Rev^d Henry Vesey Fitz-Gerald, Rector of said Parish, for Twenty-one years, from the 1st of November last -
